CHAPTER 1
GENERAL INFRASTRUCTURE



1.1 Postal and Telecommunication

1.1.1 Postal System

Bangladesh is divided into four administrative divisions comprising of sixty four districts. The NCRS project area covers eight districts and the post office uses a postal code system for easy sorting and quick distribution, see Figure VI.1.1 and VI.1.2. The NCRS is covered under one postal region viz Dhaka.

The general Post Office and head offices located at the metropolitan cities have been given 4 digit code numbers. In addition there are post offices and sub-post offices in the thana and union levels. Each of them are given a code number, see Table VI.1.1.

1.1.2 Tele-Communication System

Telecommunications contribute significantly to the socio-economic development of the country, especially in the field of government administration, and commerce. The NCRS falls within the Dhaka Telecommunication Region, see Figure VI.1.3 and has Microwave and UHF lines as shown in Figure VI.1.4

There are 15 division offices and 9 central Telegram offices in the NCRS, with 2 Telegram Offices at Mymensingh and Narayanganj. In 1990 there were 30 Nrs. Analog, 6 Nrs. Digital Telephone exchanges, 12 Nrs. T.C.B exchange, 84 Nrs. Magenta exchange, 325 Coinbox, 196 Nrs. T.P.C (includes 20 Nrs. Wireless PCO) and 539 TPBX/PMBX working. The growth of different types of exchanges in the Dhaka region since 1987 are given in Table VI.1.2.

Figure V.I.5 shows the development of telephone capacity for the different telecom divisions for the period 1973-1990. The development of the number of subscribers (working connections) by telecom division is also shown.

An international comparison of tarios-Telephone connectors per 100 people vs. GNP per capita-shows, that Bangladesh ranges at the very end, just above countries like Myanmar (Burma) and Nepal. Other Asian developing countries like China, Pakistan, India, Thailand or Indonesia register much higher telephone density figures. The slope of the regression line reveals that the number of mains per 100 inhabitants is increasing super linearly relative to the development of GNP. The countries lying above the regression line have a higher penetration of main lines than the mean value of the regression line in relation to the countries respective GNP per capita. Figure VI.1.6 demonstrates, that Bangladesh is situated well below the mean value, i.e. the country has a very low penetration or service factor.

1.2 General Facilities

Most of the facilities contributing to the Socio-economics of the NCR are discussed in SR IV. Data on educational institutions, hospitals and clinics, hats & bazaars etc. for each Planning Unit are given in Table VI.1.3. The analysis may be taken as an index of socio-economic condition of the people, and shows that the available facilities are very meager, specially the education & medical facilities.




Figure VI.1.2

Dhaka Telecommunication Region



Microwave and UHF Links





Lines per 100 Population Versus GNP per Capita



CHAPTER 2

ROADS AND RAILWAYS

2.1 Roads

The NCRS area is covered with a network of roads connecting the capital and serving other parts of the country mainly the major towns and also serving thanas, unions and villages. The roads are classified by Roads and Highways Department (RHD) into 4 categories viz National Highways, Regional Highways, Feeder Roads, and Thana Connecting Road.

The classification by LGED and local authorities differ from the RHD and this study has grouped some of these categories together as shown in Table VI.2.1. The roads are described with their location in respective Planning Units in Table VI.2.2. The length of Roads of different categories falling in each Planning Units are given in Table VI.2.3.

The total length of roads in the project area is 1143.26 km. This contains 417.08 km of National Highways, 37.00 km Regional Highways 162.53 km. Feeder Roads and 526.65 km thana connecting roads. The major road network are shown in Figure VI.2.1. The length of roads in each thana is given in Table VI.2.4.

Bridges

Due to natural land configuration of the NCRS area there are may bridges on the main roads and openings & culverts in smaller roads to permit crossing of river and flood water. The bridges on the main roads are given in Table VI.2.5.

- Dhaka-Jamalpur
- Via Joydebpur-Kaliakoir-Mirzapur-Tangail-Ghatail Modhupur.
- Modhupur-Kapasia
Via Muktagacha, Mymensingh, Trisal, Bhaluka, Salna
- Dhaka-Aricha
Via Mirpur, Savar, Manikganj, Shibalay
- Dhaka-Mawa
Via Srinagar, Keraniganj

Flood Damage to Roads: Damage occurred to road pavements & structures during the severe flood of 1988 as shown in Table VI.2.6 and in Figure VI.2.2.

2.2 Railways

The Bangladesh Railway system operates with Dhaka as its central point. As Dhaka falls within the NCRS area, the main railway systems is described with linkage to Dhaka. The main lines operating in the project area are:

- Dhaka to Bahadurabad Via Tongi, Gazipur, Mymensingh
- Dhaka to Narayanganj
- Tongi-Bhairab Bazar
via Rupganj, Narshingdi (upto Rupganj with in the project area)
- Jamalpur-Jagannathganj Ghat
via Madarganj, Sharishabari





The lines from Tongi to Jamalpur and Dhaka to Narayanganj and Tongi to Narshingdi are single line tracks. The remaining are double line tracks. The total length of double tracks are:

• Dhaka to Tongi	22.94 km
• Jamalpur to Bahadurabad	46.06 km
• Jamalpur to Jagannathganj	37.62 km

The Railway network has a total length of 289 km in the project area, see Figure VI.2.1. The railway tracks in the country are of two types (metre gauge and broad gauge), however within the NCR all the tracks are of metre gauge.

In the NCR the metre gauge sections area :

• Tongi - Gafargaon	35 km
• Mymensingh-Jamalpur	54 km
• Jamalpur-Bahadurabad Ghat	40 km
• Tongi-Ghorasal	26 km
• Tongi-Dhaka	45 km

Total: 289 km

The top width is 20' and the distance between the lines is 5'-6". The crest width of metre gauge is generally 4.9m (16) with side slopes 2:1.

The long profiles of the above sections are given in Figures VI.2.4 to VI.2.8 (dated 1988). These sections have been checked with Chief Engineer Railway, Chittagong in March 1992.

The Railways were built on high embankments with sufficient bridges and culverts. The construction period was end of 19th or early 20th century. With the passing of years many changes have occurred. Population has increased with more pressure on land use. Unplanned construction of embankments & roads have criss-crossed the drainage basin, giving rise to higher water level, causing damage to the embankments & structures in abnormal flood years. The devastating flood of 1988 caused severe damage to railway line in NCNS area. In places the embankments were overtapped, breaches occurred & bridges were washed away. The damage occurred due to 1988 flood are given in Table VI.2.7 and a schematic diagram is given as in Figure VI.2.3.

The two ferry ghats at Bahadurabad & Jagannathganj are constant headaches for the Railway Department to maintain. They are subject to frequent changes due to erosion and movement of river banks. The cost of maintenance of these ghats are given in Table VI.2.8. The seven year statistics shows that the average annual maintenance cost is approximately Taka 18 million.

The situation may change on completion of proposed Jamuna Bridge. It is prepared that the railway will have direct linkage to Jamuna Bridge and that Jagannathganj ghat will no longer be required. For this purpose the Railway Department has submitted a proposal to the Government of Bangladesh for a new line connecting Jamuna Bridge for a length of 45 km from Baira to Jamuna Bridge. The proposed alignment is shown in Figure VI.2.9. The Proposal has been submitted to Government of Bangladesh in March 1990 - by Bangladesh Railway.

Railway Bridges

Details of railway bridges have been obtained from Bangladesh Railway. Baishi bridge is significant for the flooding patterns of PUs 1,2 & 4 and its cross section is therefore shown in Figure VI.2.10.

Schematic Diagram for Showing Affected Area of Railway Line of NCR by Flood in 1988



Tongi - Mymensingh**








Ghorashal - Tongi






CHAPTER 3

NAVIGATION

3.1 Navigation

Bangladesh is a riverine country with a dense network of large and small rivers creeks, beels & haors. The easiest and cheapest means of transport for the rural population is by boat. Presently about 8000 km is navigable by large sized mechanised vessels during the wet season. Out of this almost 6,000 km are classified routes. This is reduced to 4,800 km during dry season bringing the classified routes down to 3,600 km.

3.2 Classification of Waterways

Criteria for Classification

The importance of an inland waterways is determined primarily by the nature and volume of goods or the number of passengers handled in terminal areas or ports. The mechanised (large size) cargo vessels (to be) utilized for the "large volume" and "long distance" transport flows are the determining factor in classifying waterways. This implies that the loaded "draught" characteristics of the (mechanised) cargo vessels determining the Least Available Depth (LAD) requirement, should be the leading criterion in route classification, see Table VI.3.1.

Classification

The inland waterways transport system consists of a 'hierarchy' of routes, see Figure VI.3.1 as follows:

- Class I: comprising the (perennial) Routes configuring the propeller-shaped spine of the system that inter connects Chittagong/Dhaka/Narayanganj (and extending to Bhairab Bazar/Ashuganj) - Khulna/Mongla via Barisal (Ilsaghata/Hizla) where the largest LAD of 3.60-3.90m (12-13ft) is to be maintained all year round, with a total length of nearly 685km.
- Class II: Routes (perennial) linking the major ports for the North- west and North-east hinterlands. i.e. Baghabari/Nagarbari (and further north to Chilmari) and Sylhet Region, to the Class I Routes where the next highest LAD of 2.10-2.40m of (7-8 ft) is to be maintained all the year round with a total length of 1,000 km.
- Class III: Routes, where it is usually not feasible to maintain perennial routes with a LAD exceeding 1.50-1.80 m (5-6 ft), either 'transit routes' such as: Zakiganj-(Fenchuganj)-Ajmiriganj-Dilalpur (Kushiyara - and Kalni R.) or 'feeder' routes connected with Class I or II routes (e.g. stretches of Kanagsa R.: Titas R.: Lakhya R.: 'Route around Dhaka':Karnafuli R.: and the 'tidal' rivers in the south-west/central region; with a total length of slightly less than 1,900 km.



Class IV: Routes ('feeders') basically seasonal routes, where it is not feasible to maintain a LAD of 1.50 m (5ft) in the dry season, with a total length of about 2,400 km.

Clearly, a number of routes need to be improved in order to meet the proposed classification standards, notably Class II and Class III routes which are at present seasonal routes (Kushiara- and Kangsa rivers, the 'Route Round Dhaka', etc).

In terms of network lengths, the classified perennial routes(Class I, II and III) would eventually amount to almost 3600 km, and classified, largely (90%) seasonal routes to almost 2400 km altogether almost 6000 km.

Description of Routes

The classified waterways that interconnects the terminal areas (ports) are called Routes. They are named after the connected places of traffic generation. The navigation routes are not confined to one waterway or just one river. All routes pass through a number of rivers of different depth and width.

The routes are classified into the following groups:

Class I

Class I: Routes are the main arteries of traffic flow and are the major concern of BIWTA as regards conservancy and maintenance. The users shall have a guarantee to the specified navigability within reasonable limits throughout the year. This is attained by dredging the channels or banadalling as required. The routes with their present LAD are given in Table VI.3.1 whereas a detailed description of the routes and their sections is presented in Annex 1.3.4.2 A R.1.3 Annexes to Maps of Phase I NCRS Reconnaissance Report.

The total length of above 6 Nrs. class 1 routes are 1139 km of which only a small part lies in NCIS area. These are Dhaka/Narayanganj portion of the SI. Nrs. 1 & 2 above. One course commence at Dhaka port following along the Buriganga river to the Dhalaswari river, the other commence at Narayanganj port via Sitalakhyा river. The second route coming downstream from Dhaka/Narayanganj proceeds southward to the Meghna river.

Class II

Class II Routes are important traffic links, see Table VI.3.2. The necessary aids for navigation shall be provided such as marking of channels by buoys and beacons and notification of depths. But no guarantee can be given for the availability of the specified depth throughout the year. Dredging may be carried out incidentally to be determined case-by-case.

Class III

Class III Routes are traffic links of regional importance. BIWTA carries out (simple) channel markings as required. The specified Route navigability may be expected during the greater part of the year. There are fourteen routes under this category, see Table VI.3.2

Class IV

These are called feeder routes. They are basically seasonal routes where it is not feasible to maintain a LAD of 1.5 (5ft) in the dry season. In total there are 2400km in the country under this class distributed in 45 Nrs. of routes. Of these there are only eleven (11) routes covering a length of 400 km in the NCRS area, see Table VI.3.2, that have been classified; however there are many others class IV routes in the NCRS area that are not yet officially identified.

A schematised presentation of the waterways network is shown in Figure VI.3.1.

3.3 Ports and Traffic

3.3.1 Sea Ports

There are two sea ports in Bangladesh viz Chittagong and Mongla. Both of them are outside the NCRS area. These two sea ports handle the total volume of cargo received or forwarded. To give a general idea of the quantum of cargo handled by these ports & their share in percentage of the total volume for the year 1989-1990, see Table VI.3.3.

3.3.2 Inland River Ports

There are 11 (eleven) number inland river ports, is Bangladesh:

- Dhaka
- Narayangonj
- Chandpur
- Barisal
- Khulna
- Patuakhali
- Baghabari
- Aricha
- Nagarbari
- Daulatdia
- Narsingdi

Of these ten 3 (three) viz Sl. 1,2 & 8 are located in the project area. The above ten inland river ports have been developed by BIWTA and provided with modern port facilities. The description of facilities provided in 3 (three) of these ports falling in the NCRS project area are:

- i) **Dhaka Port** :- Position Lat 23°42'-30" N. Long 90°31'25"E. Formally opened on June 1967. Facilities: 2 in No. two storied terminal building, 3 RCC jetties, 2 Ramps 20 Pontoon jetties.
- ii) **Narayanganj Port** :- Position Lat 23°37'N. Long 90°31'-15"E. Formally opened in 1965. Facilities : 1 in No. two storied terminal building, 8 RCC jetties 10 pontoon jetties, 8 Godowns covering 62,000 sft.
- iii) **Aricha Port** :- Position Lat 23°50'-N. Long 89°47'E.
(Manikgonj)
Formally opened in March 1983. Facilities : One terminal shed, 1 Pontoon, 3 ferryghats with pontoons and two Ro ferryghats, parking yards and additional passenger sheds (details not specified).

3.3.3 Launch Stations within NCRS Area

At some distance from the main terminal pontoon but within the port area launchghats exist at the busy traffic points:-

Launch stations have also been developed outside the port area by BIWTA with pontoon & ferry facilities, see Table VI.3.4 give a list of launch stations under the administrative jurisdiction of Sr.Deputy Director ports & traffic, Dhaka and Narayanganj ports. This list contains stations outside the NCRS area but within the administrative jurisdiction of Dhaka & Narayanganj.

3.3.4 Cargo Traffic

A list of the cargo traffic handled at stations under Dhaka and Narayanganj ports are given in Table VI.3.5.

3.3.5 Cargo Freight Rate

The main BIWTA ferry ghats are in the vicinity of the NCRS project area and the river Jamuna divides the country into two district parts VIZ East and West. In absence of the proposed Jamuna Bridge these ferries are the main connecting link between the two parts of the country. The following maximum freight rates are effective from the dates shown against each service for carriage of vehicles by BIWTC ferry services. In addition BIWTA terminal charges are to be paid for each vehicle. Passenger/Driver/Conductor/ Helper/Bicycle rider will have to pay fare as per rate vide fare chart for ferry services and sea truck services, see Tables VI.3.6 and VI.3.7.

3.3.6 Operation & Control of Water Ways

For smooth & efficient operation and control on the Waterways the entire navigable waterways has been divided into the following zones:

- Dhaka Zone
- Narayanganj
- Barisal Zone
- Khulna Zone
- Northern Sirajganj Zone
- Sylhet Zone
- Chittagong Zone.

The NCRS area falls mainly into the Dhaka Zone, but also parts of Narayanganj and the North Zone.

Dhaka Zone

The zone comprises of Dhaka, Munshiganj and Gazipur Districts and also includes Tangail and part of Jamalpur Districts. It is bounded in the North by the old Brahmaputra River, in the East by the Bender and the Lakhya River in the North-West by the Railway line from Jamalpur to Jagannathganj Ghat (excluding the ghat), in the west by the Jamuna upto Aricha at its confluence with the Padma, in the South-West by the Padma upto Chandpur (excluding Chandpur). It does not include Taltala on the Dhaleswari, but includes station on the left bank of the Jamuna.

Narayanganj Zone

The Zone comprises of the Comilla, Narayanganj and part of Brahmanbaria District and the half of the North by the boundary of the country in the West by the Brahmaputra (excluding the river) and then by the boundary of the Dhaka (vide para 1 above), in the East by the Dhaleswari River (including the River upto Durgapur) and then by the Railway line upto Bhairab and in the South by the Chandpur-Laksam Railway line (including Chandpur).

North (Sirajganj) Zone

The zone comprises of Dinajpur, Rangpur, Bogra, Rajshahi, Pabna, Tangail, Jamalpur and Sirajganj Districts. It extends in the North and the West upto the boundaries of the country in the East upto the Brahmaputra (including the river) and the boundary of the Dhaka zone (vide para-1) and in the South upto the Padma (including the River and the Goalando ghat).

3.3.7 General

The river system in Bangladesh as a whole & the project area rivers in particular are deteriorating over a long period due to both natural & morphological process. According to BIWTA master plan the condition is further aggravated due to dry season withdrawal for irrigation purpose. Moreover the action of building structures as for FCD/I may in some case have adverse effect on the navigable waterways unless due consideration is given at the design stage.

CHAPTER 4

HYDRAULIC INFRASTRUCTURE

4.1 Embankments

There are a significant number of embankments with various size and sections in the NCR area constructed by several agencies at differing times. These embankments give certain benefits and disbenefits, towards flooding of the area.

4.1.1 Institutions Involved in Embankments

Bangladesh Water Development Board(BWDB): The main purpose of BWDB embankments are to protect agricultural land from major river flooding. In most cases BWDB embankments along interior rivers form part of FCD/I projects.

Bangladesh Railway Department(BRD): The main purpose of BRD embankments are to carry goods & passengers. However, in many cases they serve a secondary purpose of a flood embankment, see Section 1.2.

Road & Highways Department(RHD): RHD embankments are mainly for interdistrict communication. In many cases they also work as flood embankment, but in some cases they obstruct passage of flood water creating high afflux between upstream & downstream causing more damage to the upstream flood areas, see Table VI.1.1.

Thana Embankment: Local (Thana) embankments are constructed to provide communication links to unions, villages and important places within the thana. They are constructed under the authority of the thana administration with assistance from a variety of sources (e.g. LGED). They may play a limited role to protect flooding but are mainly for communication purposes. If not constructed properly with sufficient cross-drainage structures with proper design, they are likely to create drainage congestion in the area.

Food For Work Programme (FWP): FWP embankments are constructed by the local authorities mainly to generate scope of employment for local people. They may be for internal communication or flood control or both depending on the area & location.

It is generally only the BWDB embankments that have been built specifically to address the problem of providing protection against flood. Embankments are discussed in more details in SR VII paragraph VII.1, and are also listed as part of existing FCD/I projects in Chapter 5 of this report.

CHAPTER 5

FLOOD CONTROL, DRAINAGE & IRRIGATION

5.1 Administration

The BWDB is responsible for implementation of FCD/I schemes in the NCR area. The NCRS area falls under the jurisdiction of the Chief Engineer, North Eastern zone with its head office at Dhaka. Two circles headed by two Superintending Engineers and four divisions headed by four Executive Engineers are responsible for the implementation of the project in the NCR :-

Recently one additional circle has been created in Tangail to look after the Tangail compartmentalization Pilot Project of FAP-20.

5.2 Existing and Previously Proposed Schemes

In the Phase-I study of the NCR, data were collected from the MPO, BWDB, NGO's LGED and other Organisations. These lists were presented in Annexes 1.1.1.1A and 1.4.1.1.B in R.1.3 Annexes & Maps I, annexes of the Phase I Reconnaissance study. During the phase II study an inventory of the existing schemes has been prepared taking into consideration the list of schemes in the previous study and updated by field visits to divisions and circle offices. The list consists of 56 projects of which 34 Nrs. are completed (c) 11 Nrs. are on going (OG) and 9 Nrs. are proposed (P) Projects. The list of the projects are given in Table VI.5 and the locations are shown both in Figure Vi.5.1 & in Map VI.1 (see back of report). These schemes are described further in SRs II.2 and VII.

In addition during the Phase-I study a list of required works on FCD/I schemes due to 1988 flood damage were given in Annex 1.4.1.4A. The information were collected from Flood Damage Restoration Project (FDR) of BWDB-BETS 1988. The list is not repeated here.



CHAPTER 6

OTHER SCHEMES IN THE NCR

6.1 General

In addition to the FCD/I scheme in the NCR there are many other activities and projects being carried out in the region. The extent of these activities can be appreciated by the number of NGOs engaged in such activities in the region. There are a total of 413 Nrs. NGOs (including branches) engaged in various structural & development activities in the region, see Table VI.6.1. Further details of the NGO's working in the region are given in Annex I.

6.2 Jamuna Bridge Project

The Jamuna Multipurpose Bridge will connect the East and West regions of the country. The Bridge is located as shown in Figure VI.6.1 and will connect Sirajganj on the West and Bhuapur in Tangail district on the East Bank. A detailed location of the bridge is shown on Figure VI.6.2.

The length of the Bridge will be about 4,800m and is bounded by guide bunds of the river training works. The substructure comprises large diameter steel piles with concrete pile caps and piers. The super structure will be of composite steel box guider and concrete slab in spans of 100m. The guide bunds each having length of 2,700m will protect the bridge abutments, the bridge end facilities and the approach embankments and viaducts at each bank. Road & Rail approaches are to be constructed on embankments on the flood plain above maximum flood level. The connection of railway with the bridge on both banks as given in the Jamuna Bridge Report (JMBA 1991) is shown in Figure VI.1.2. The location of guide bunds are shown in Figure VI.6.2.




Jamuna Bridge/Dhaleswari Mitigation Study

The Jamuna Bridge Authority's (J MBA) plan to cut off the northern intake of the Dhaleswari has direct implications on the NCR and in particular the area around Tangail including the FAP 20 pilot area. The impact of the bridge on water levels and the river morphology is significant and thus the NC RS has to consider all possible development scenarios both with and without the Jamuna Bridge being implemented. The Dhaleswari Mitigation Study have also investigated the impact of a guide bund downstream of the Jamuna Bridge. This has also been considered in the NCR planning process.

6.3 Jamuna Fertilizer Factory Road

The Jamuna Fertilizer Factory is located at Tarakhandi near Sharishabari in the project area. The project was started in January 1988, completed in December 1991 and commenced trial production from December 31, 1991. The factory is due to go for commercial production from July 1992. The production capacity is 5,61,000 MT of Urea per year, and 33000 MT of Ammonia per year. The project is based on natural gas supplied from Titas gas field and is financed on loan from Government of Japan.

The main road communication to the Jamuna Fertilizer Factory Company (JFC) from Dhaka is via Tangail but from Bhuapur near Tangail to Tarakhandi (JFC site) the road is not good. The JFC is therefore providing the cost of road surfacing with the work being executed by RHD under their Tangail & Jamalpur division. The road generally follows the existing BWDB flood embankment with minor straightening and other small scale improvement (see Figure VI.6.3). The length of the road from Bhuapur to Tarakhandi is about 28 km. It will have a paved width of 5.49 m and shoulder to shoulder width of 10.79 m. The side slopes are 1:2 on both sides. The formation level of the road at the beginning at Bhuapur will be 15 m and at the end at Tarakhandi will be 19.6m.

The roads formation level will not be adequate to withstand peak floods. According to NC RS design the top level of the embankment at Bhuapur should be at 16.04 m to withstand is 100 year flood. A letter has been sent by NC RS to FPCO (dated 02/02/1992) and copied to the JFC and RHD pointing out that the formation level should be some 1 to 1.4m higher than presently proposed.

The latest information collected from EE. BWDB Tangail on 18.04.1992 indicates that the works are in progress. The surfacing of the road is being done on the existing formation level. The surfacing consists of one layer of harrying bond bricks on edge over a layer of one brick flat soling. The surfacing will be replaced after 2-3 years when the embankment will be consolidated and the permanent surfacing will be done.

6.4 Industries

Most of the industries developed in Bangladesh are located in and around Dhaka, Narayanganj, some are in Chittagong & Khulna and very few in other districts. Though Bangladesh is not an industrially developed country, industries are gradually developing in many sectors. Most of the sectors are to meet the domestic requirements but some are partially or mainly export oriented like Tea, Jute, Leather, Ready made garments etc. The total number of major industries in important sectors are given in Table VI.6.2.




The industrial centre of Bangladesh is Dhaka and Narayanganj and falls within NCRS project area. Table VI.6.2 shows that about 58.6% of Jute, 82% of Leather 54% of Medicine 57% Cosmetics 61% of industrial Chemicals 100% of Diesel engine, 50 to 69% of all type of Electrical industries, 59% Textile Mills and 81.7% of Ready Made Garment industries are in the NCRS area. This has an environmental and socio-economic impact on the people living in the project area. About 85% of the workers of garment factories are female.

Bangladesh has few foreign exchange earnings and is not rich in natural resources. However some foreign exchange is covered through exporting industrial items like Jute, Leather, ready made Garments, Tea etc. in and exporting of human resources for employment. The ready made garment industry alone accounts for about 44% of the countries total export earning. This year the export is likely to fetch about Tk. 4,000 croes equivalent to about one billion US dollar.
