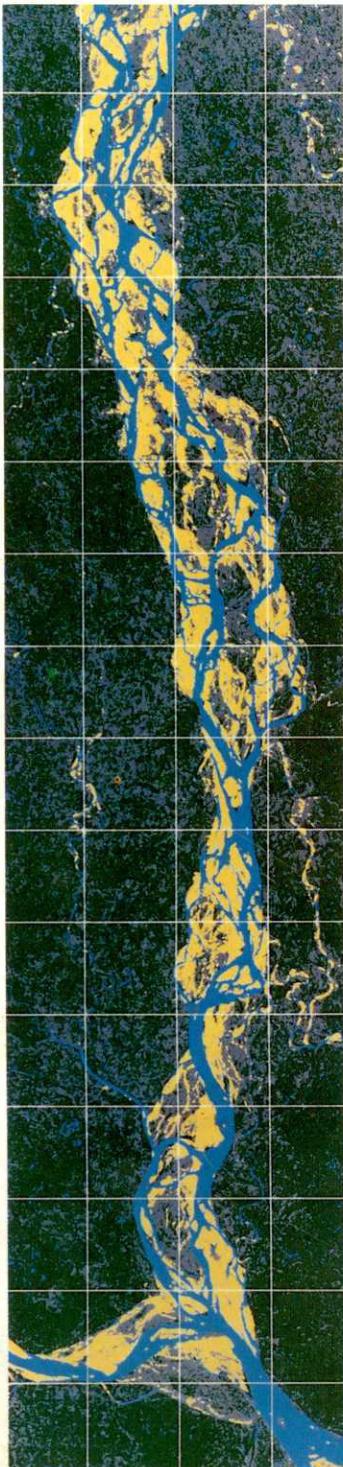

1 BACKGROUND

The Project was awarded by the Flood Plan Coordination Organization (FPCO) represented by the Kreditanstalt für Wiederaufbau (KfW) to the Joint Venture Rhein-Ruhr Ingenieur-Gesellschaft mbH as lead partner, Compagnie Nationale du Rhône, Prof.Dr. Lackner & Partners and Delft Hydraulics in association with Bangladesh Engineering and Technological Services Ltd. (BETS) and Desh Upodesh Ltd. (DUL).

The Consultancy Agreement was signed on October 14, 1991. The date of commencement was fixed on December 01, 1991.

On the occasion of a project appraisal mission from 26.01.1993 to 07.02.1993 by KfW and CFD the results and recommendations of the Planning Study were discussed in tripartite meetings of FPCO, KfW/CFD and the Consultant. The study's overall concept was agreed to by FPCO and KfW/CFD.

As to the sequence of the activities, however, there was a preference to have a general discussion on river training prior to any further investigations and to formally finalize the FAP 22 Planning Study with that meeting. It was therefore agreed to obtain an Experts Opinion on Jamuna River Training/AFPM strategies by holding a discussion with a team of reputed experts in the field of river training and river basis management, and the Consultant was requested to make respective arrangements.

The other result of the discussions was the installation of the Final Stage of Phase I, after finalizing the main services of the Planning Study (Phase I) on 31.10.93 and before starting the Test and Implementation Phase (Phase II) on 01.06.1993. The Final Stage of Phase I served to prepare modified work and staffing schedule for Phase II, to receive and discuss the comments on the Draft Final Report, to prepare the respective answers and to issue the Final Report including the relevant comments. The costs of the Final Stage of Phase I are covered by the balance of the funds for Phase I.

The Letter to Proceed into the Test and Implementation Phase (Phase II) was issued on May 15, 1993 and the Test and Implementation Phase started on June 01, 1993.

The so called EXPERTS DISCUSSION on river training/AFPM of FAP 22 was held in Dhaka on 2nd, 3rd and 4th of November 1993.

A Technical and Financial Proposal for Extended Studies on Recurrent Measures was submitted in July 01, 1995 respectively February 1996. The Consultant started activities for Phase I of the studies in July but interrupted the activities until the Client agreed to the execution of activities of Phase I in March '96. The Study Report Phase I was submitted in August 1996. Client and Donors with their comments to this report requested further information on design and works, but gave the green light to start the physical tests immediately to avoid delays in the execution.

In July 1996 the Consultant proposed an extension of the monitoring phase of project up to December 1999 due to the postponement of the works at the second test site at Bahadurabad for one year. The Client approved Scenario B of the proposal on March 1997 up to the financial limits of the TAPP second revision (January 1997).

During the monsoon season 1997 and the following dry season severe erosion occurred further downstream from the Revetment Test Structure at Bahadurabad. Following the demand of the local population for suitable protection of their land and homesteads, WARPO requested the donors KfW and AFD during their review mission in July 1998 to agree to the implementation of a third test site at Ghutail, about 4 km downstream from the Revetment Test Structure. Since the test structures at Kamarjani and Bahadurabad had been implemented within the available budget and taking into account a cost estimate for their monitoring and maintenance until the completion of the Project by the end of December 1999, remaining funds of about DM 8.4 million were estimated. Taking further into account the intention to utilise the contract amount up to 100 %, it was agreed between the donors, WARPO and BWDB in July 1998 to implement a third FAP 21 test site at Ghutail.

Immediately after the decision had been taken in favour of a third test site, the Consultant started necessary investigations and surveys and arrived finally at the conviction that any test structure at any suitable test site on the Jamuna could not be completed before the monsoon season 1999. It was therefore suggested in letter No. CC/F21-22/WARPO-KfW/L/98-332 of November 01, 1998 to start the actual construction of the third test structure after the monsoon season 1999 only.

The Consultant submitted a "Proposal for Modification of Consulting Services for Test Sites" in December 1998. This proposal is based on a project duration up to end of the year 2000.

After incorporating the comments of the donors a revised version (Revision No. 1) was submitted in May 1999. The Donors and Client approved this revision. Hence all tables of this report have been modified accordingly regarding the quantity of man-month and other related quantities.

2 SUBCONTRACTS

2.1 General

The Consulting Agreement (Letter to Proceed) provides for four subcontracts to be executed under the Project, namely

1. Topographic, cadastral and bankline surveys (item 5.1)
2. Construction and test running of a Filter Test Rig (item 5.2)
3. Physical modelling of sites (item 5.3)
4. Subsoil investigations (item 5.4)

In addition special physical model investigations on falling aprons have been provided (item 4.1).

These model tests on falling aprons have been executed through the Laboratory division of the joint venture partner CNR in a small bypass channel of the river Rhône in France.

2.2 Subcontracts Concluded

Out of the above mentioned subcontracts, No. 3 has been concluded. Subcontract 1 is scheduled over several periods, four survey campaign has been concluded so far. The construction of the Filter Test Rig under Subcontract 2 has been finalized, the test have been executed between May 30, 1994 and September 22, 1994.

A. SUB CONTRACT MANAGEMENT REPORT FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF ADAPTATION WORKS ATTRIBUTED TO CONSORTIUM: THE ENGINEERS LTD. AND COROLLA CORP (BD) LTD.

1. Basic Data

In order to implement these works, the Consultant has decided to issue a variation order to the Contractor in charge of the works of Kamarjani I, rather than going to a new tendering procedure, by using updated rates and in order to keep both original administrative and technical contract conditions.

V.O. No. 4 was therefore issued on 12.02.1996, which is financially independent from the Test Site I accounts, since a final account was agreed with the contractor as reported previously.

The Adaptation works under V.O. could not been finalized in 1996/1997 season. Works continued in December 97.

The scope of works was extended by some additional items including the maintenance of the site and the camp up to December 1999. The new figures are:

Items 1 to 9 deal with the Consultancy Services and items 10 to 20 with the different Test Structures/Test Sites.
